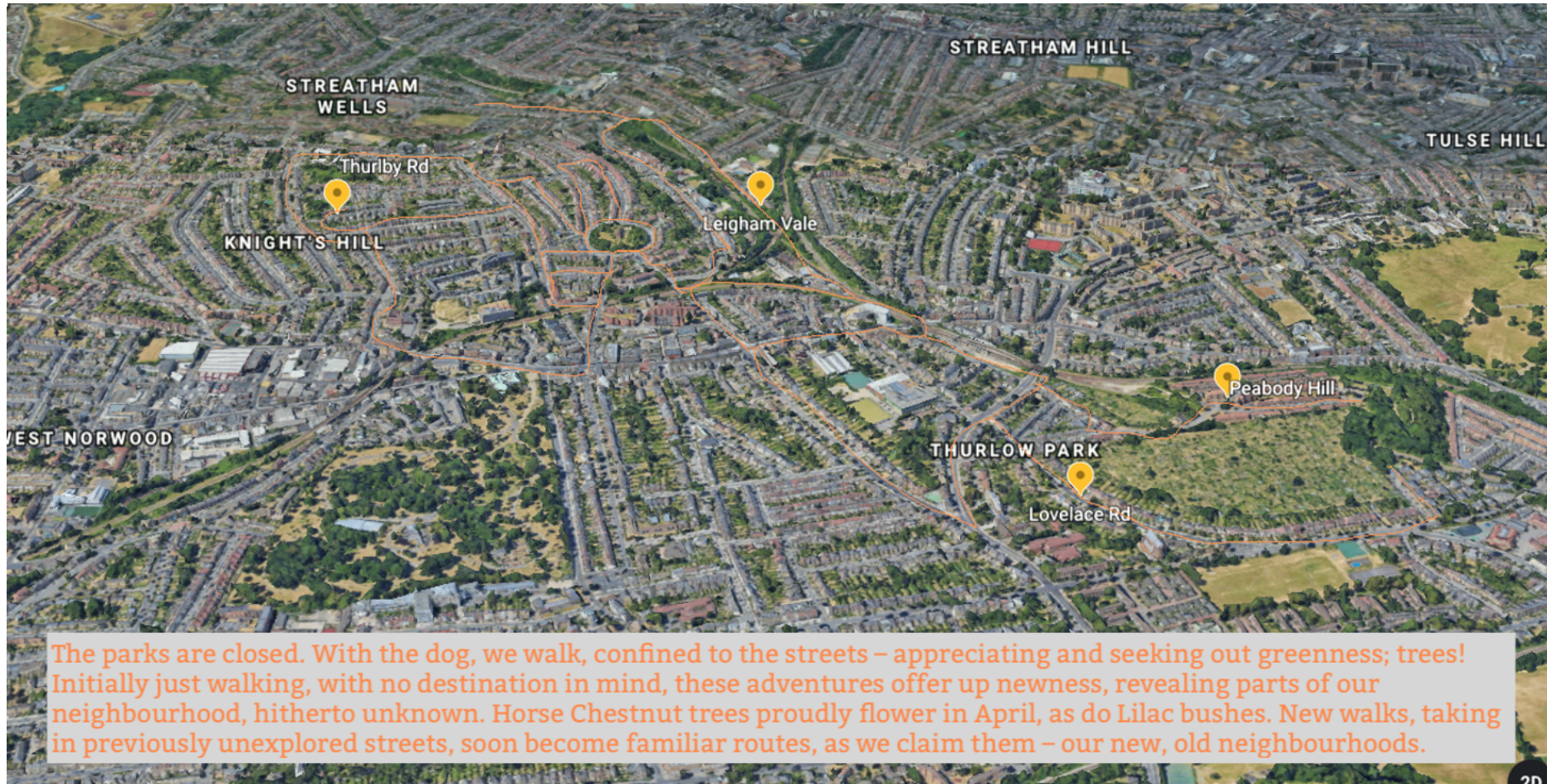


Christina's map

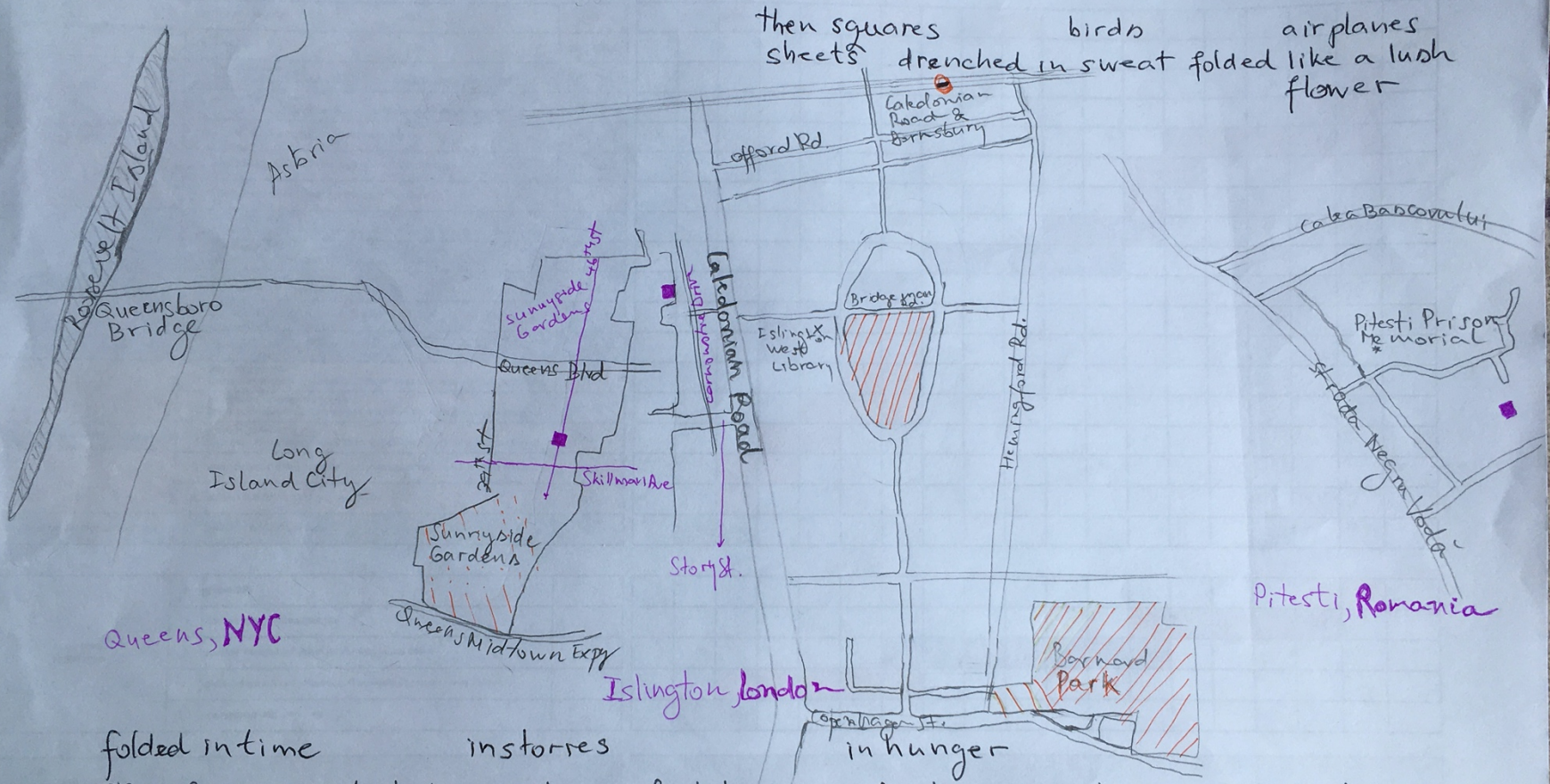

IN-BETWEEN HOMES

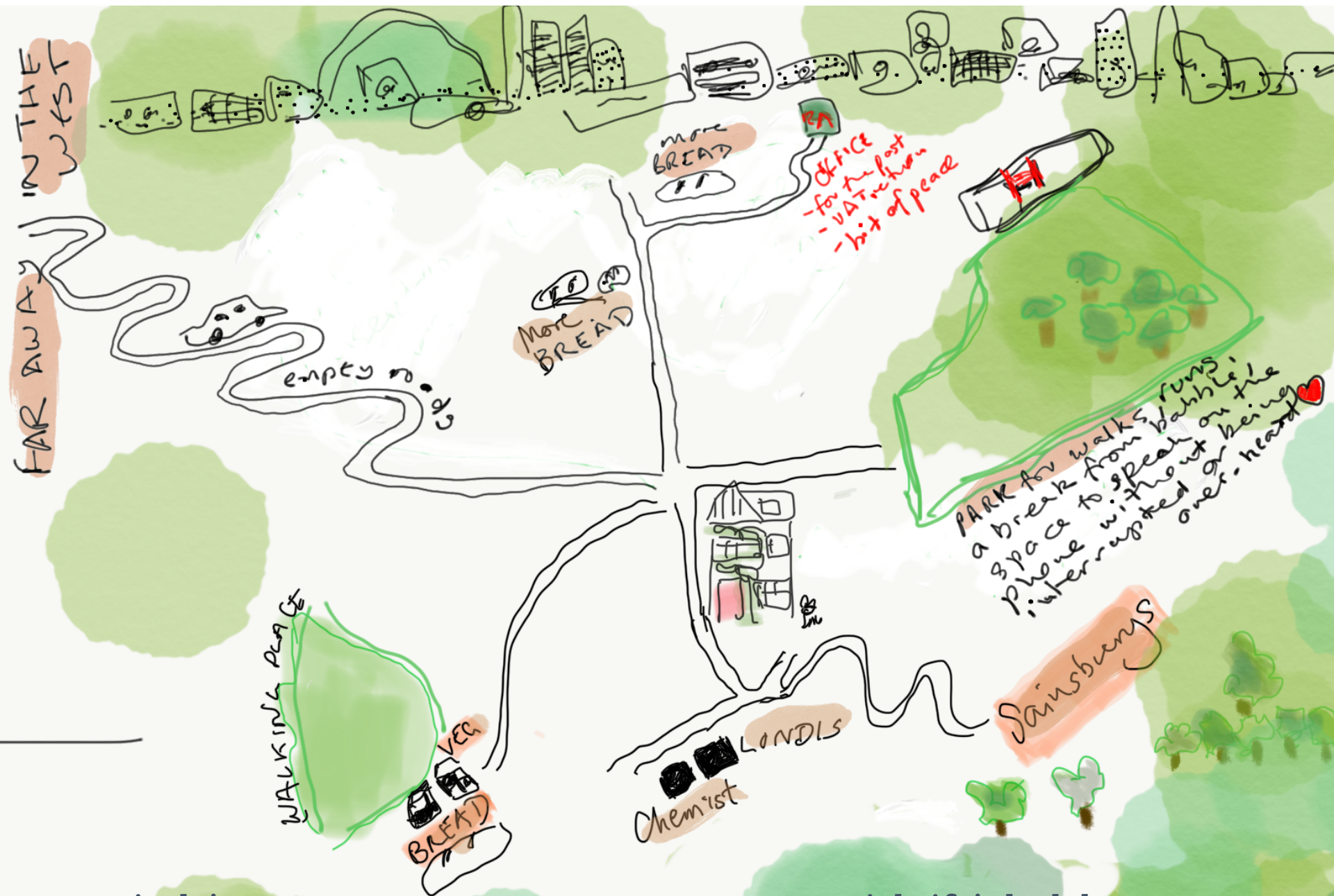


folded in time instories

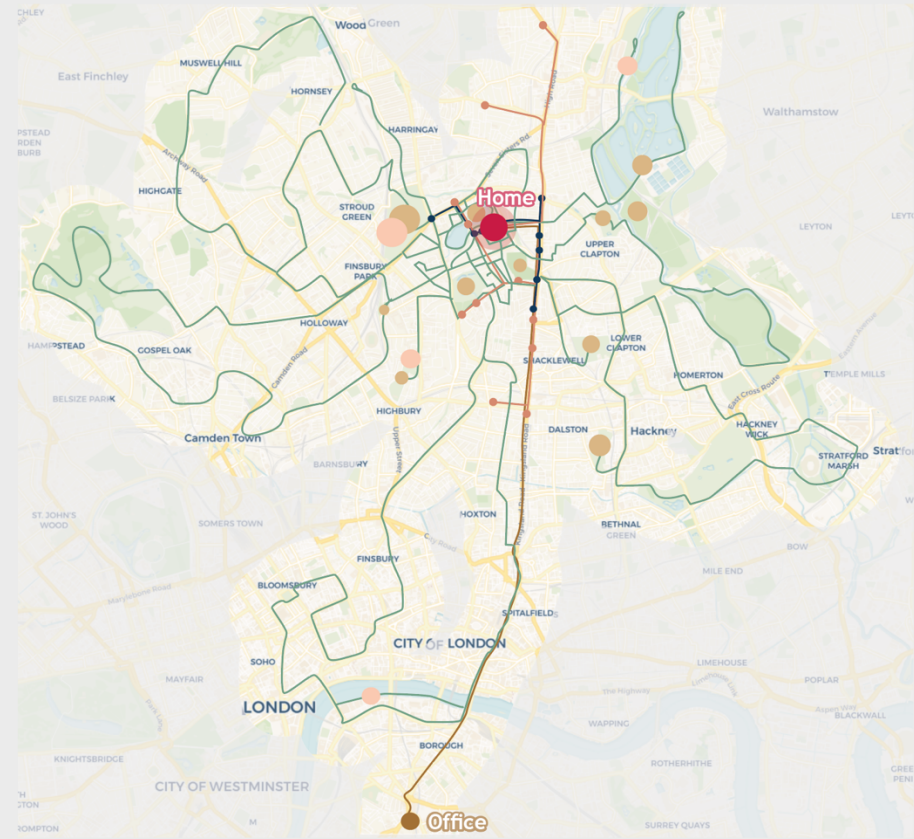
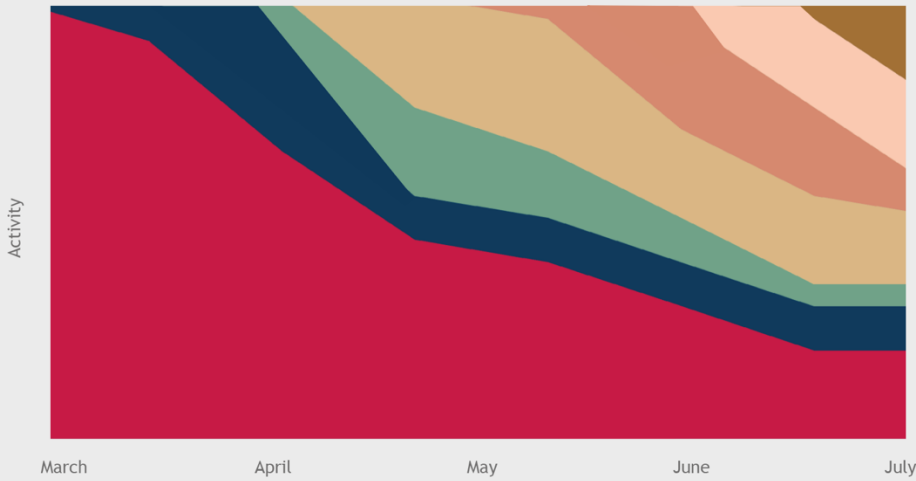
